- Learn seemingly simple, yet highly effective, communication tools, such as Powerful Non-Defensive Communication, the curious question, and the importance of narrative.
- Learn how to satisfy your professional ethical obligations while at the same time screening clients for any contraindications for collaborative practice, laying the foundation for success, and assisting clients in making truly informed choices about the conflict resolution process that best meets their needs.
- Leave this training embracing the concept of a values-based practice by clarifying your core beliefs about collaborative practice and how those beliefs shape your work with your client and the interdisciplinary team.

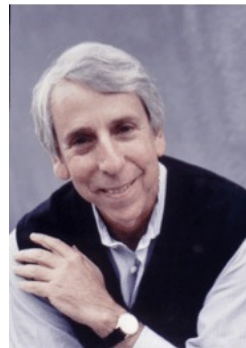
Pauline H. Tesler, JD, CFLS is a pioneer in extending
